The Penn Township Board of Commissioners met in a regular session on Monday, May 18, 2020, via an online meeting. President Heiland called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with a roll call of members. Present were Commissioners Brown, Elksnis, Heiland, and Van de Castle. Also present were Solicitor Hovis, Township Manager Rodgers, Police Chief Hettinger, Fire Chief Clousher, Township Engineer Bortner, Zoning Officer Smith, MS4 Coordinator Hirt, and Township Secretary Sweeney.

Public Safety – Commissioner Elksnis:

Commissioners Elksnis/Van de Castle moved to authorize the Township Manager to apply for the PEMA/FEMA Public Assistance DR-4506 – COVID-19 Grant. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioners Brown/Van de Castle moved to approve an agreement with Smith Elliott Kerns & Company, LLC, providing audit and accounting services to the Township for years 2020, 2021, and 2022. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Brown/Van de Castle moved to adopt a proclamation honoring the Graduating Class of 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Health & Sanitation – Commissioner Elksnis:</u>

Commissioners Elksnis/Van de Castle moved to approve the Chesapeake Bay Countywide Action Plan Implementation Grant agreement.
