

ORDINANCE NO. 635

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DISSOLVING THE RECREATION BOARD, ABSOLVING THE POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES GRANTED TO THAT BOARD.

WHEREAS, The Penn Township Recreation Board was created by the Board of Commissioners on November 16, 1987 for the purpose of supervising, maintaining and regulating parks, recreation areas and facilities; and

WHEREAS, The Penn Township Board of Commissioners desires to approve the termination of the Recreation Board and assume the duties and responsibilities associated with and authorized by the Recreation Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Penn Township hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Dissolution of Recreation Board

The Board of Commissioners hereby dissolves and terminates the Penn Township Recreation Board.

SECTION 2. Authority of Board of Commissioners

The Penn Township Board of Commissioners hereby assumes the duties and responsibilities of preparing and adopting the annual recreation operating budget; supervising, maintaining and regulating parks, recreation areas and facilities; adopting, revising and amending rules and regulations as it deems necessary and proper for the use and operation of the recreation parks and facilities. The Penn Township Board of Commissioners shall equip and operate the parks, recreation areas and facilities and shall, for the purpose of carrying out these provisions, employ officers or employees as they deem necessary and proper. The Penn Township Board of Commissioners shall have supervisory authority and responsibility over general Township recreational programs.

SECTION 3. Severability

If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, said invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed. Ordinance No. 349 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Amendment To Township Code


The Articles hereby adopted shall be deemed to be incorporated into the Penn Township Code so that reference to the Code shall be understood and intended to include such changes.
